CHILD helps Haitian directly

CHILD is supporting a convoy consisting of experienced team of humanitarians along with 12 Canadian doctors that will be traveling from Dominican Republic to Haiti to deliver medicine, and water for the victims of the recent earthquake. This convoy is set up by efforts of a young Iranian humanitarian Leila Makarechi from Laguna Niguel, CA.



As many of you know, CHILD's program for the new generation of Iranians is called Youth Ambassador of Hope. Leila Makarechi, 23 years old, Founder and President of an NGO called "180 degrees for Cooperation and Development" was recognized by CHILD as a Youth Ambassador of Hope in 2008. This NGO works with Haitians and Dominicans to provide better living conditions for the

poorest of the poor. Leila herself worked with Haitian children for several summers. As a result of this very hard work, they now have electricity, running water, and new schools in sugar cane fields where the Haitian children work.

Leila was in Haiti in 2009 with the United Nations team to promote a better understanding of how the U.N. can help the Haitian situation. Most of the UN workers that died in this earthquake had worked with her. She has extensive and direct experience in many charitable organizations. She has worked in India forming Diabetic Clinics in rural villages. Her most recent project is for Chernobyl.

This convoy can deliver the much needed help by avoiding the airport situation and assisting the victims directly.
